Carbon Monoxide Warning

A dangerous leak of carbon monoxide gas can accumulate in your home or business that cannot be smelled or seen because carbon monoxide is odorless and colorless.

When breathed in even small quantities, carbon monoxide is absorbed into the bloodstream and can cause death, serious injuries, or permanent disability.

Symptoms of carbon monoxide exposure include the following:

- Unexplained nausea, chronic headaches, eye irritation;
- Visible soot or discoloration at warm air outlets;
- Condensation on indoor surfaces.

If you believe you are exposed to and breathing carbon monoxide:

- Get everyone out of the house or building to fresh air;
- Turn off all appliances in the house or building and call your gas supplier;
- Seek medical attention if you are suffering from nausea, headaches, eye irritation, or dizziness.

Because carbon monoxide is odorless and colorless, a dangerous leak of carbon monoxide may accumulate in your home or business which cannot be detected by smell or sight. The only way to discover or detect the leak may be through the installation of a carbon monoxide detector.

For these reasons, you should install one or more UL approved carbon monoxide detectors in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Your failure to install one or more carbon monoxide detectors may result in death, serious injury, or permanent disability to you and to anyone else in your home or building.

Your supplier has not tested carbon monoxide detectors and does not endorse or recommend any particular make or model. Failure to follow all of the instructions provided by the manufacturer may reduce the effectiveness of the detector.
